NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these Show. Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany these Show Premium List.

A recording fee of 50 cents and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. These AKC fees are to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2)

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All Trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

RETURNED CHECKS/INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

The show-giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 and less will not be issued due to the cost of processing.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 am each show day. Dogs must be removed DAILY from the show site immediately following completion of the last scheduled class. All dogs present must be on leash or confined except when being judged. Do not leave dogs in closed vehicles.

Exhibitors must keep dogs under control and restrained at all times. Crating allowed only in designated areas. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Utah State Law requires all dogs over four (4) months of age be current on rabies vaccination.

Exhibitors Must be governed by any rules and regulations of the Salt Lake County Equestrian Park and/or local restriction. Dogs not entered at these shows are not allowed on the show grounds. All dogs present must be on leash or confined except when being judged. Failure to comply will result in charges being brought before the Show Committee.

The Show Committee reserves the right to make such other regulations as they may deem necessary (not to conflict with AKC rules) on the day of the show.

The judging procedure may be modified to accommodate disabled handlers.

Entries must be submitted on an American Kennel Club Official Entry Form or exact copy (both front & back) and must be signed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks. The Club and/or its Show Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry or for entry in a class for which the dog is not eligible to compete or entering the same dog twice.

Care of the Show Site

Care of the facility is of utmost importance to the clubs hosting these events. Whenever it shall be determined that misuse of a hotel/motel room or show site may have occurred, the AKC Event Show Committee shall convene for the express purpose of an on site inspection of the area in question.

Misuse of the Show Site includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Smoking in Non-designated Areas
- Allowing dogs to relieve themselves in areas other than those designated for that purpose
- Failure to clean up after any dog in your care in any area at any time
- All dogs must be crated in rooms. Bathrooms are not considered a crate area and are not to be used to house dogs.

In the Event of a Complaint: should it be determined that destruction and/or misuse of property has occurred, the following steps shall be taken to correct the matter

- Monetary restitution shall immediately be made by the violator(s) to the group/institution impacted.
- The person(s) found in violation of the show rules or AKC rules or rules of the hosting clubs shall be asked to leave the premises immediately.
- If suspended from AKC privileges, the offender's name(s) shall be published in the *The AKC Gazette* as having violated said rules.
